COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Athletes may enter up to three events in either Western or English style.
- Each competitor must complete a waiver from Bunker Park Stables.
- Barrel class and pole weaving events are only open to riders in classes A, B1 and C1 only.
- Unified Drill team will not be offered due to low participation numbers.
- Athletes must provide their own horse if registering for showmanship, barrel class or pole weaving.
- Proper footwear is required for all riders. Please consult the Special Olympics Official Equestrian Rules for proper footwear requirements.
- Helmets are required for all athletes.
- Bitless bridles will be allowed.
- Per Special Olympics Rules, hackamores will not be allowed EXCEPT for barrel class and pole weaving.
- The arena will be open for riding on Thursday 2:30 p.m. 8 p.m. and Friday morning before 7:30 a.m.
